ATTENTION SENIOR CITIZENS, VETERANS & TOTALLY DISABLED ANSONIA RESIDENTS

It is that time of year again when the Assessor's Office will be processing the Elderly Homeowner's and Additional Veteran's Exemption applications. For the homeowner's application, the process begins 02/01/2021 and ends 05/14/2021. For the additional veteran's program the process begins 02/01/2021 and ends 10/01/2021. You must be <u>65 years or older</u>, an <u>honorably discharged veteran</u> and/or <u>permanently and totally disabled</u> and cannot exceed the income limits (below) to qualify for this program.

The combined taxable and non-taxable income limit for this year is \$37,600 for single residents and \$45,800 for married residents. In order to apply, all official tax documents proving 2020 income must be provided along with a completed application, no exceptions. If you file an income tax return, please contact us for an appointment *after* filing, as we will need a copy of the return and backup documents.

Appointments are held Monday, Wednesday and Thursday from 9:00a.m to 2:00p.m in the Assessor's Office, located on the main level of the City Hall, first office on the right hand side when entering the front entrance. The handicapped entrance is located at the rear of the building. **The space will be disinfected between appointments, masks are required**. Due to the health pandemic we will also be accepting applications and attachments via snail mail.
