#### ▲ **Description**

The ProAct Prescription Drug Discount Card program helps residents save money on their prescription medications any time their prescriptions are not covered by insurance. Discount cards are distributed in participating municipalities and may be used at any participating retail pharmacy. City residents can also print a card by visiting [www.CTRxDiscountCard.com](http://www.CTRxDiscountCard.com).

#### ▲ **Savings**

Participants can expect to save 52% on average. Discounts will vary depending on the drug and quantity purchased. Discount cards can also be used to save on medications prescribed to your pet that can be filled at participating retail pharmacies.

#### ▲ **Who's Eligible**

The cards may be used by all city residents regardless of age, income, or existing health coverage. There are no enrollment forms, no membership fees,

and no restrictions or limits on frequency of use. Cardholders and their family members are encouraged to use the card any time their prescriptions are not covered by insurance.

#### ▲ **What It Costs**

This program is completely free of charge to both the town and participating residents. Simply take the discount card along with a prescription to a participating pharmacy and start saving.

#### ▲ **Participating Pharmacies**

More than 62,000 pharmacies nationwide accept the card, including most chain pharmacies and many independent pharmacies. There is a 98% pharmacy participation rate amongst participating municipalities.

#### ▲ **Additional Benefits**

## DISCOUNT CARD

The ProAct Prescription Drug Discount Card program helps residents save money on their prescription medications when their prescriptions are not covered by insurance.

## WHO'S ELIGIBLE

The discount cards may be used by all residents regardless of age, income, or existing health coverage. There are no restrictions or limitations on frequency of use. We encourage all residents to keep a discount card on-hand, to ensure they will never pay full cash price for their prescriptions.

## WHAT IT COSTS

This program is completely free for Ansonia and its residents. There are no applications or enrollment fees. Simply take the discount card along with a prescription to a participating pharmacy and start saving.

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## SAVINGS

On average, participants can anticipate saving 10-20% on name brand medications and 20-70% on generic medications. Discounts will vary depending on the drug and quantity being purchased. Cards can also be used to discount certain pet medications. The program also provides discounts on vision, hearing, and LASIK services. A discounted dental plan is also available, which costs only \$36.50 per year for an individual and \$52.00 per year for the entire family.
